Soccer Update: Nadine, Kelly, Darryl

- AGM is coming up: want budget issues submitted
- Darryl and Nadine went over budget to break it down by program
- Still need to get treasurer stuff from Doug
- Approx. \$5000 came in in April – soccer related
- Soccer cost us about \$7000 for the year
- Grass cutting was very high
- Apportioned all costs out to Talons, House League, Micro, Us
- Soccer is expensive for us to run
- Grant from the City doesn't cover expenses
- Dunrobin supports more than the other communities
- Prior to this, we could never prove how much soccer cost us
- Soccer summary has been forwarded to WCSC
- We are responsible for a full field at the Community Centre, a full at the high school, 2 mini's at the high school, a full at Stonecrest, a mini at Stonecrest, and then more for the tournament
- We don't get more from WCSC but it costs us more
- Other communities have memberships
- Options: User fees go up, rental fees go up, or divest ourselves of all soccer field cutting

Kelly: discussion about grass cutting

- Grass cutting sharing for tournament could be the argument
- We contract Jake's to do the grass cutting but WCSC can call Jake's to go cut grass
- School board cuts 3 times
- Cost should be shared
- House league never uses Stonecrest but we are responsible for it
- Need to be careful with our contract with the City
- Stonecrest was built about 6 years ago
- Lots of complaints about the quality of fields at High School

Registration for Soccer:

- April 1 is registration deadline
- \$130 before April 1 and \$160 after April 1
- Online will be available in January
- In-person registration will be done when hockey is done – March 7, 9-12 am

Ice Tenders: Received three

- 1. \$3000 to make, \$1300/wk to maintain: \$16000 would rebuild at \$0
- 2. \$1365 to make, \$1365/wk to maintain: would charge to rebuild
- 3. \$2500 to make, \$875/wk to maintain: would also run canteen
- Booked #3 (Tom) for 2 years
- Angie and Alison will field calls for community service hours and call Tom
- Tom to plan canteen
- Will have access and lockup
- Not our responsibility to staff the canteen

- Will talk to Wayne to finalize details
- Ice needs to be in by Dec 15
